- Thank the legislator(s) and staff for meeting with you today and for attending the presentation.
- Be relatively brief, no more than 30 minutes.
- Share personal experiences that shed light on this issue: Why does protecting immigrants' rights matter to you? State key reasons for your views.
- Refer to specific bill numbers.
 - [H.2418/S.1579](#): An Act to protect the civil rights and safety of all MA residents (SCA)
 - [H.3456/S.2289](#) An Act relative to work and family mobility during and subsequent to the COVID-19 emergency (WFMA)
 - [H.1979/S.1205](#) An Act establishing fairness for agricultural laborers (FFA)
- Does the legislator support the bill(s)? Check to see if they have signed on as a co-sponsor by clicking on the bill number above.
 - If YES, thank them for their support and request a date for a public hearing for SCA and FFA (WFMA already held hearing) the next step in the legislative process.
 - If NO or not yet, ask them for their support.
 - Counter any arguments the opposition may use.
- Do they sit on these Joint Committees: [Labor and Workforce Development](#) or [Public Safety and Homeland Security](#)?
 - If YES, ask when we can expect a public hearing for the bills.
 - If they sit on [Transportation](#), ask them to vote the WFMA favorably out of committee.
- Thank them for their time and be sure to send a thank you via email or follow up communication.
- Be sure to tweet a thank you to your legislator. Remember to tag us at @LWVMA, your legislator, and use the hashtags #MASafeCommunities, #DrivingMAForward
