### **An Act relative to building energy and decarbonization**

### **An Act to create offshore clean energy and new renewable jobs**

Bill number(s): [H.3302/S.2158](#)

Sponsors: Rep. Dylan Fernandez and Sen. Julian Cyr

#### **Purpose of the bill:**

1/6 to 1/3 of fossil fuel generating plants are projected to close in the next decade due to decreased costs and availability of renewable energy and regulatory and legislative mandates. The need to boost renewable energy sources is urgent; we are in a race to replace polluting fossil fuels with clean, renewable energy to meet emissions reductions targets required in the new climate law and the Administration's Clean Energy and Climate Plan (CECP). Offshore wind is one of the most plentiful natural energy sources we have for meeting this requirement and the NE coast is ideally suited for this industry due to the abundance of wind offshore and shallow waters.

**H.3302/S.2158** will promote additional large, offshore wind generation solicitation and procurement needed to transition from fossil fuels as quickly as possible. This bill includes provisions governing:

- offshore wind contracts;
- requirements on contractors that include adherence to prevailing wage and labor laws;
- support for minority business involvement by requiring diversity and inclusion plans in contracts with reporting on results;
- promotes private, institutional & municipal procurements;
- includes environmental protections to avoid, mitigate and minimize environmental impacts, with monitoring requirements.
- requires an independent evaluator of bids; requires distributor and winning bidder co-operation.
