



## By-Mail Voting

- To vote by mail, apply for a ballot using the application sent to your home, online at [bit.ly/3Qwi1UC](https://bit.ly/3Qwi1UC), or download an application at [bit.ly/3c6buku](https://bit.ly/3c6buku). Your ballot will arrive in a few days.
- The applications and the mail-in ballots come with prepaid postage.
- Return your ballot by mailing it, depositing it in your town's ballot drop box, bringing it to your local election office, or dropping it off at an early voting location.

## Register to Vote

- Register or pre-register to vote, update your address, or party online at [registertovotema.com](https://registertovotema.com).
- Or download a paper application from the Secretary of State's website.

## In-Person Voting

- Vote early in-person. Early voting hours and locations are on your town's website (early voting may not be at your normal polling place.)
- You can vote on Election Day between 7 am and 8 pm.

<b>August 27</b>	Voter registration deadline (for Primary Election)
<b>August 27- September 2</b>	Early voting period (for Primary Election)
<b>August 29</b>	Mail-in ballot application deadline (for Primary Election)
<b>September 6</b>	Primary Election Day
<b>October 22 - November 4</b>	Early voting period (for MA Election)
<b>October 29</b>	Voter registration deadline (for MA Election)
<b>November 1</b>	Mail-in ballot application deadline (for MA Election)
<b>November 8</b>	Massachusetts Election Day
